North Lambeth Parish is a vibrant and diverse inner-city community in the heart of London. The Parish consists of St Anselm's Church, Kennington, St Mary's Eco Church and St Peter's Church, Vauxhall.

#### At St Anselm's:

- We are a friendly, diverse, family-orientated Liberal Catholic congregation who are grounded, pragmatic and enjoy humour.
- Our ministry offers a variety of forms of worship, from traditional services to innovative eco-focused ministry.
- We are keen on music, including our children's choir, Young Voices, an active adult choir and a steel pans group.
- We are inclusive of all, irrespective of gender, ethnicity or sexuality.
- We preach love and forgiveness to all in our community.
- We work to serve those around us, breaking down barriers and supporting those most in need. We are ambitious to see positive change in our community.
- We seek to enable the children of Kennington to fulfil their potential, working with local charities that offer mentoring and opportunities to those who are socially excluded.

# About the role

### We are looking for an ordained, or lay Children, Young People and Families Minister. The overarching objectives of the post are to:

- lead and develop the provision of pastoral care to children, young people, and families within the St Anselm's congregation and to those within the local community who seek Christian support and nurture.
- develop links across the community that enable children, young people, and families to flourish and reach their individual and collective God given potential.
- represent the needs and perspectives of children, young people and families, in how the Parish identifies its priorities and delivers its plans.

# Primary responsibilities

#### At St Anselm's, the role is to:

- co-ordinate the delivery of weekly Sunday School provision that is relevant to the different ages of those attending.
- recruit, train and supervise volunteers to assist in Sunday School and other children's activities.
- ensure adequate Crèche provision is available during Sunday 10am worship services.
- deliver a mid-week mother, baby, and toddlers' group (Church Mice).
- take a full and active part in the ministry team, attending weekly team meetings and team prayers and other team related activities.
- ensure the safety and welfare of children and young people in church and produce up-to-date policies and risk assessments for activities and events.





# Additional areas of responsibility

#### At St Anselm's Church you will:

- assist clergy in the planning and delivery of the children's talk during the
   10am Eucharist service.
- assist clergy in the preparation of young people for Confirmation and reception into Holy Communion.
- assist clergy and the head server in training and supporting children in Sanctuary serving roles
- support and oversee the development of ministry to young people and teenagers, including supervising any lay or volunteer staff.
- work with the uniformed organisations (for example Boys' Brigade and Girl's Association) that meet in church and to develop All Age Worship and Parade Services, in collaboration with the staff team.
- work with the St Anselm's Music Director and Deputy Director, with particular focus on supporting and developing our children's choirs.
- actively encourage the participation of children from across the parish in trips and activities as appropriate



#### There are also additional tasks around liaison with Archbishop Sumner Church of England Primary School. These include:

- maintaining strong links between the Church and the school, ensuring that relevant support is provided to children and families as appropriate.
- assisting clergy in delivering weekly Parish Assemblies
- assisting clergy in delivering end of term services and specific worship services during Lent and Advent
- developing systems and structures to support Christian identity in children moving from Primary to Secondary education.

#### Mission and outreach

- To seek new opportunities for outreach and evangelism to children and families in the local community – with a particular focus on issues currently faced by families and young people.
- To foster working relationships with other local organisations, including the Evelina Children's Hospital at St Thomas', who focus on family flourishing and wellbeing.

# Parish life

#### St Anselm's Church

St Anselm's church has seen growth on the back of its lengthy commitment to being engaged in many aspects of local community life and commitment to working alongside others. It has become attractive to those who want a blend of traditional church with vestments and weekly Eucharist within an atmosphere that is not too rigid but relaxed and welcoming. It often has almost as many children attending under the age of 16 as it does adults.



Church Mice, a group for babies and toddlers and their carers takes place on Thursday mornings and there is a large Sunday school as well as Young Voices and Joyful Noise youth choirs. There is a small Wednesday morning service followed by coffee and fellowship. We are keen to make our worship engaging, participative and relevant.

#### St Mary's Eco Church

St Mary's Eco Church was created in 2021 by Lambeth Palace and the Diocese of Southwark to respond to the climate emergency and biodiversity crisis. The Team Vicar post is funded through Strategic Development Funding from Southwark Diocese.



Our vision is to create innovative spaces for people to encounter each other, the rest of nature, and God, celebrating our differences and diversity. Like different organisms form communities, we see St Mary's as a metaphorical wildflower meadow formed of small communities of distinct flowers and species, all interconnected beneath the soil. 


## Parish Profile

# North Lambeth Parish is a vibrant and diverse part of inner-city London in the exciting urban context of the Kingston Episcopal Area of the Diocese of Southwark and the Archdeaconry of Lambeth.

North Lambeth Parish is an area of great diversity. It is in the London Borough of Lambeth and the Vauxhall Parliamentary constituency. St Anselm's is in Kennington, which is a residential area with an array of restaurants, pubs and shops. Waterloo station lies on the north-eastern edge of the Parish. Several hotels have been built along the river's edge from Lambeth Bridge to Vauxhall station. There are a number of ongoing regeneration projects at present in the Parish which should also have a positive impact on the local environment and community facilities.

The Parish runs from Westminster Bridge Road in the North to Kennington Lane in the South. On the West it is bordered by the River Thames and to the East by Kennington Park Road (see map below). The Parish population is around 20,000 in an area where there is significant deprivation next to great wealth.



The Parish population can be broadly split into living in three types. More than half the population live in several large local authority, densely populated housing estates, where there is a wide variety of ethnic groups, amongst which African and Caribbean are prominent. There is a high proportion of single-parent families. Another quarter live in homes provided by London and Quadrant Housing Trust; and the rest are privately owned houses and flats which, because they are close to central London and within the Division Bell area of the House of Commons, are relatively expensive.

These diverse communities are part of the character and wealth of the area – yet pose challenges for creating a strategy for Christian outreach. In addition, both churches attract non-resident Parishioners – particularly at St Anselm's. There are two Buddhist centres within the Parish and Geraldine Mary Harmsworth Park has the Tibetan Peace Garden.

In addition to Archbishop Sumner Primary School, which is linked to the Parish, there are four other schools in or very near the Parish. Support is given to all schools and scope exists for further developing links between school and Parish life. The Parish includes a Community Care Centre, youth and community groups and Vauxhall City Farm. Both St Thomas' Hospital and Lambeth Palace are within the Parish boundary. The Oval cricket ground, the South Bank and the Imperial War Museum are nearby.
